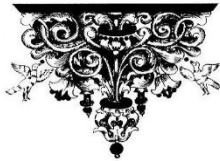

On the First Hour

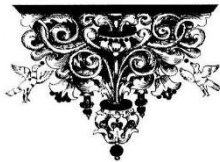
After the Psalms, Alleluia &

On the Third Hour

Tone 6:

O Lord, Who didst send down Thy
Most-holy Spirit at the third hour
upon Thine apostles, take Him not from
us, O Good One, but renew Him in us
who pray to Thee.

Verse 1: Create in me a clean heart, O
God, and renew a right spirit within
me.

Verse 2: Cast me not away from Thy
presence, and take not Thy Holy
Spirit from me.

Гласъ ѿ:

Иже въ шестый день же и часъ, на крѣтѣ пригвождѣнъ въ раи дерзновѣнный а́дамовъ грѣхъ, и согрѣшѣній нашихъ рѣкопие́нїе раздери́ хрѣтѣ бже, и спси́ насъ.

Стіхъ б́: И́зъ къ егѹ воззва́хъ и гдѣ оубы́ша мѣ.

Гласъ и́:

On the Sixth Hour

Tone 2:

O Thou Who on the sixth day and hour didst nail to the Cross Adam's daring sin in Paradise, tear asunder also the handwriting of our sins, O Christ God, and save us.

Verse 1: Give ear, O God, unto my prayer, and disdain not my supplication.

Verse 2: As for me, unto God have I cried, and the Lord hearkened unto me.

O God, be gracious unto us, and bless us, and cause thy face to shine upon us, and have mercy on us.

On the Ninth Hour

Tone 8:

O Thou Who at the ninth hour for our sake didst taste of death in the flesh, mortify our carnal mind, O Christ God, and save us.

Verse 1: Let my supplication draw nigh before Thee, O Lord; according to Thine oracle give me understanding.

Verse 2: Let my petition come before Thee, O Lord; according to Thine oracle deliver me.
