
Restoration of Lienz Memorial Chapel

Dedicated in 1971 to the memory of the victims of the tragic events that took place at Lienz, Austria in May and June of 1945, the St. John the Baptist Memorial Chapel, located at St. Vladimir's Memorial Cemetery in Jackson, New Jersey, has suffered the effects of time, weather, and vandalism.

The Kuban Cossacks Library & Museum has undertaken the urgently needed restoration of the Chapel. Phase one of the Chapel restoration, which includes replacement of the Chapel's crumbling brick exterior and entryway, has now been completed.

The next phases of the Chapel's restoration are currently being planned, and include: resurfacing of the Chapel's metal roof, re-gilding of the cross and cupola that top the chapel, replacement of the Chapel windows, repair or replacement of the Chapel entry door, as well as repairs and improvements to the Chapel's interior.
